WHAT TO *expect*

After booking, you can feel free to talk to me about your wedding ideas and plans as much or as little as you wish. I will always be available to answer any questions by phone or email.

If you have a engagement session included in your package, we will find a date that works and discuss what you may wish to do for it. It's a great time to learn how to pose. It's also an opportunity to get to know me, and for me to get to know you even more.

I'm really relaxed and my aim is to capture beautiful, moody, storytelling photographs of your day. This is your wedding and I want to reflect you, your personality and style as much as possible.

After you've picked out a package the next step is to have a real conversation. We can meet at a coffee shop, your home, or any place you would like. If it's not possible to meet in person, we can talk on the phone or video chat.

While we may be talking through your planning stages, at six weeks before your wedding day, I will send you a questionnaire to fill out. This helps me get to know you guys even more. I ask questions about the timelines of your wedding day, which help me figure out logistics of your day, and plan when we can run away for some incredible fine art portraits.





ENGAGEMENT

session

LOCATION

As I work with clients in many different destinations, please email a list of locations specific to your area. I generally like to stick to locations that provide a natural shooting environment, such as a local state park or other outdoor area. However, if you have a location with sentimental value in mind-the place he proposed, or a favorite local cafe or brunch spot-we can chat about including it in your shoot.

To provide you with as much shooting time as possible, I recommend choosing no more than two portrait locations.

TIMING

I generally begin shooting during the golden hour period that occurs two hours before sunset. I also offer times during the day/afternoon as well. Sunrise shoots are also available-however, please keep in mind that it can be more difficult to coordinate hair and makeup for a sunrise session. I have the greatest amount of availability for engagement sessions on weekdays as our weekends are typically spent shooting weddings. Sunday dates may be available, but can be reserved no more than one month in advance to allow for wedding bookings.

OUTFIT

Deciding what to wear is one of the most difficult parts of the engagement session planning process. I recommend narrowing down your selections by choosing one casual and one dressy outfit. For your dressy look, I recommend long flowing dresses that you can twirl around in. Dresses in solid neutral/muted tones or simple patterns that show texture and movement always photograph beautifully. Typically, heels are great. However, we recommend wearing lower heels or dressy flats if you and your fiancé are of a similar height. If your engagement session is taking place during the fall or winter, bring a coat to wear between locations. Bring a pair of flat, comfortable shoes so that you can walk between locations easily.

HAIR & MAKEUP

First things first: It's important to get your hair and makeup done professionally. I would personally stick to very natural looks, but again it's your special day and there's nothing more I want than for you to be comfortable!

Your engagement session presents an excellent opportunity to schedule a trial run with the hair and makeup team you will use on your wedding day. If they happen to be unavailable, consider scheduling a makeup appointment at Sephora (or similar). Let your makeup artist know that you're having your makeup done for a photoshoot—they will need to apply more product than usual for your look to show up on camera. Be sure to bring the lipstick you're wearing with you in case touch-ups are needed during our shoot.







WEDDING DAY



BEFORE THE CEREMONY

Prepare and gather items for detail shots. The rings, bouquets, wedding invitations, jewelry, boutonnieres, shoes, and cufflinks are all gorgeous details that shouldn't be forgotten! It's helpful for your wedding photographer to rely on a bridesmaid or other helper to organize these items, so make sure to keep them close!

THE CEREMONY

When walking down the aisle during your ceremony, remember to take your time, keep your chin out and most of all SMILE! This can help make sure all the pictures of you, your groomsmen and bridal party all have those perfect aisle shots!

I do also ask the officiant to step to the side after pronouncing you husband and wife. There's nothing better than getting those amazing first kiss pictures!

THE RECEPTION

Make sure you plan enough time for the wedding reception. This is the big one. More than anything else please, please make sure you give yourself plenty of time during the wedding reception. If you are travelling from one venue to another make sure to take the travel time into account. The standard for the bride and groom to enjoy their wedding reception seems to be an hour. Make sure you also have about 45 minutes to an hour for all of the bridal party & groomsmen pictures!

THE PARTY

Upon meeting with the DJ, confirm what kind of lights he/she plans on providing. Ensure that laser lighting will not be used as they can cause odd and distracting multi-coloured spots over you and your guests.

Smash cake in your partner's face! Whisper all the dirty secrets! Get down on the dance floor like no one's watching! Light sparklers and skip under the starlit sky. Pop bottles, take shots (after all the formal photos have been taken, of course), and make faces at your best friends. Enjoy the night and have the most legendary celebration ever!

FREQUENTLY

asked questions

HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE YOUR PHOTOGRAPHY STYLE?

I am more of a creative moody photographer. My style would be known as, artistic, tasteful, moody, unique & emotional. I love capturing the mood of your special day. There is nothing like receiving your pictures and having them take you back to that very moment you've waited so long for. I certainly do pose when it comes time to take the formal shots and portraits - but throughout the day, I'm more of a fly on the wall taking photos as they happen without being too in-your-face.

HOW MANY PHOTOGRAPHERS WILL BE AT MY WEDDING?

My Heirloom package includes a second photographer. You could even choose to add a third photographer if that's what you would like! However, you can always add a second photographer to any package that you choose! I always recommend having a second photographer because they are always capturing the moments that aren't always seen by everyone as well as covering different angles!

DO YOU PHOTOGRAPH GROUP PICTURES?

Yes I offer group pictures. This is typically used for the closest friends or family of the bride and groom. However, I do not extend my services to backdrop photos during the reception! Photographers tend to stick around for backdrop pictures but they usually end up missing all the action on the dancefloor! I will request a group photo list before the wedding.

DO YOU OFFER CUSTOM PACKAGES?

Yes. I can customize anything to make sure the final package fits your needs perfectly. I have three premade wedding packages that you can look from and make your own! I also offer an intimate wedding package that is perfect for a smaller wedding day with an abbreviated coverage.

HOW LONG IN ADVANCE SHOULD I RESERVE MY WEDDING DATE?

If you're thinking of having your wedding on a Saturday, then earlier is better. Generally speaking, as soon as you've booked your venue, you should begin your search for a wedding photographer and put down a retainer as soon as you can!

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE TO GET MY PHOTOS?

Standard turnaround time for delivery of your photos is 3-6 weeks after the event date - however, depending on the time of year it may be sooner.

DO YOU OFFER ENGAGEMENT SESSIONS?

Absolutely and I highly recommend an engagement session with your photographer before the big day! It's an opportunity to get used to being behind the camera with your partner as well as getting to know your photographer! Engagement shoot pictures are also used for invitations and save the dates!

WHAT ARE YOUR TERMS OF PAYMENT?

I require that you put a 20% initial non refundable deposit to secure the date and the rest is to be paid a week before the shoot/event. Post-processing of the images will begin only after the final payment is completed.

WILL MY PHOTOS APPEAR ON YOUR WEBSITE?

I only use a very small selection of photos that are relevant on our pages and online profiles. If the images are used it is for self promotion. Your album would be posted on my website for future brides to see, however I will respect your wishes if you do not want your entire album posted.

WHAT HAPPENS IF IT RAINS?

Don't worry, I will still be by your side without any hesitation! I would still be sure to capture your big day even in rainy or snowy weather. You know what they say, if it rains on your wedding day, the knot is hard to untie so it is good luck!

ARE THERE ANY EXTRAS TO BE ADDED TO THE TOTAL PRICE?

There are always add ons and extras that you can add to your package but I do not add any other costs besides travel. I don't charge anything extra for travel provided your wedding location is within a 50-mile radius of Thornhurst, Pennsylvania. Outside this area, I will discuss with you and supply a quote price for travel, and accommodation where necessary.

HOW DO WE RESERVE OUR WEDDING DATE?

Let me know your date so I can check my availability. You could either go on my website (www.lucidmemoriesbydelycia.com) and request a booking date or you can shoot me over an email (lucidmemoriesbydelycia@gmail.com). Once we select the best package for you, I will send you a contract and booking form to sign and instructions on how to pay the retainer.
